- (a): The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) is implementing MSME Champions Scheme in order to enhance competitiveness of MSMEs to make them competitive in foreign markets. MSME Sustainable (ZED) Certification Scheme, a component of the MSME Champions Scheme, provides financial support for technology up-gradation for moving towards zero effect solutions including green technologies.
- (b): The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) has taken several initiatives to promote innovation and entrepreneurship in MSMEs. These, inter-alia, include MSME Innovative Scheme, Entrepreneurship and Skill Development Programme (ESDP) and Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP). These schemes support entrepreneurship of MSMEs and employment generation through self-employment in the country.
