SUPER SPECIALITY HOSPITALS

*252. SHRI SELVAM G.: SHRI C.N. ANNADURAI:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of super speciality hospitals functioning in the country, State/UT-wise including Tamil Nadu and Odisha;
- (b) whether the Government has failed to develop super speciality hospital in each district of the country and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) the challenges faced by the Government while setting up super speciality hospitals in the country;
- (d) whether the Government has taken steps to provide all the infrastructural facilities in such hospitals and if so, the details thereof and if not, the corrective steps taken in this regard;
- (e) whether the Government has identified places in each district where such super speciality hospitals will be set up and if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) whether any timeline has been fixed by the Government for the expeditious completion of the above-said projects in the country and if so, the details thereof?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 252 FOR 17TH MARCH, 2023

(a) to (f): The Government of India provides financial assistance to States/UTs to set up and upgrade health infrastructure for providing universal access to equitable, affordable and quality healthcare services including super speciality services to the people through various schemes like the Pradhan Mantri-Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM) and Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY)

For creating tertiary healthcare infrastructure, under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) component of PM-ABHIM, provision has been made for establishment of 602 Critical Care Hospital Blocks (CCBs). The details of State/UT wise and year wise allocation is at **Annexure-I**. In 2021-22 & 2022-23, administrative approval for establishment of 175 Critical Care Hospital Blocks has been accorded across various States & UTs as per proposal submitted by them. State/UT wise details including that of Tamil Nadu and Odisha is attached as **Annexure –II**.

Under the Central Sector component of PM-ABHIM, establishment of 150 bedded Critical Care Hospitals Blocks in 12 Central Institutions has also been approved. The list is at **Annexure-III.**

Under PMSSY, the establishment of 22 new AIIMS has been approved, which provide for Super Speciality Services. The list of AIIMS is at **Annexure-IV**.

Further, under PMSSY, there is a provision for upgradation of existing Government Medical Colleges/Institutions (GMCIs) by way of setting up of Super Speciality Block (SSB)/Trauma Centre. So far 75 projects have been approved under the Scheme in various phases. State/UT-wise projects approved under PMSSY including Tamil Nadu and Odisha are at **Annexure-V**.

The main challenge faced by the Government while setting up super speciality hospitals in the country includes availability of encumbrance free land, statutory approvals, availability of human resources, etc.

Infrastructural facilities as regards SSBs/ CCBs are approved on the basis of the gap analysis in consultation with the concerned State Government.

Both PMSSY and PM-ABHIM have been approved for the period 2021-22 to 2025-26 and the timelines for individual projects under these schemes is as per their approved Detailed Project Report (DPR).
