- (c) the details of division of such athletes into male and female athletes respectively; and
- (d) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to increase such participation?

(d): Sports, being a State subject, it is responsibility of State Governments and Union Territory (UT) Administrations to take steps for promotion and development of the sports in their respective States/UTs so that more and more sportspersons from their States and UTs achieve the levels of excellence to participate in international sports events including mega sports such as Olympic Games and Commonwealth Games.

On its part, the schemes of the Ministry of Youth Affairs aiming at increased participation in international sports events are applicable to sportspersons from across the country including that from Andhra Pradesh.

The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports is providing financial assistance to recognized National Sports Federations (NSFs) towards training of athletes which includes all requisite facilities for their preparations including wholesome nutritious diet, food supplements, equipment support, state-of-the-art infrastructure, lodging, travelling facilities, services of reputed Indian and Foreign Coaches/supporting staff, scientific & medical support, sports kit, etc. besides financial assistance for their training abroad and participation in international competitions in India and abroad through the Scheme of financial assistance to NSFs. For the said purpose, an Annual Calendar for Training and Competition (ACTC) budget is approved for each NSF every year.

Further, elite Athletes are selected and provided with financial assistance like Out of Pocket Allowance (OPA), equipment support, coaches etc. under the Ministry's Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS).
