(a) to (c): Extension of Nuapada-Gunupur line upto Therubali (79.15 km) was included in the Budget 2017-18 subject to requisite approvals. Government of Odisha was requested to share 50% cost of construction and to provide land free of cost. Government of Odisha has agreed only for providing land free of cost. Detailed Project Report (DPR) of the project has been prepared. As per DPR, the cost of the project is approx. `1165.89 crore excluding the cost of land. At present, the project is not sanctioned, as such, no time line can be fixed for making it operational.
