STATEMENT

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 333 FOR 23.03.2023 REGARDING PRODUCTION OF SOLAR ENERGY

(a) & (b) Government has set a target of achieving 500 GW of installed capacity from non-fossil fuels, including around 270 GW of solar capacity, by 2030.

(c) As on 28.02.2023, a cumulative solar power capacity of 64.38 GW has been installed in the country. In addition, solar projects of around 51.76 GW capacity are under implementation & another 39.69 GW are under tendering stage.
