ANGANWADI CENTRES IN MADHYA PRADESH

*348: SHRI VIVEK NARAYAN SHEJWALKAR:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Anganwadi Centres in Madhya Pradesh (MP) which are being run in rented buildings including the rent fixed therefor;
- (b) the number of Anganwadi Centres in MP which are being run in Government buildings;
- (c) the number of Anganwadi Centres in Gwalior and Shivpuri districts at present;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to increase their numbers in future; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (e): A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

Statement referred to in reply to Part (a) to (e) of Lok Sabha Starred Question No.348 by Shri Vivek Narayan Shejwalkar to be answered on 24.03.2023 regarding “Anganwadi Centres in Madhya Pradesh”

(a) As informed by the State of Madhya Pradesh, there are 24,434 Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) running in rented premises in the State. As per the guidelines for Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0, rent per AWC/mini AWC is as under:

- i. Rural/Tribal - Rs.2,000/- p.m.
- ii. Urban - Rs.6,000/- p.m.
- iii. Metropolitan - Rs.8,000/- p.m.

(b) As informed by the State of Madhya Pradesh, there are 72,701 AWCs running in Government Buildings.

(c) As informed by the State of Madhya Pradesh, presently there are 1459 operational AWCs in Gwalior District and 2408 operational AWCs in Shivpuri District.

(d) & (e) Presently there is no proposal pending before the Government of India for increasing the number of AWCs.
