### \*385. SHRI ASHOK KUMAR RAWAT: SHRI DHARMENDRA KASHYAP:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of projects completed, pending and ongoing along with their latest status as on date under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) during each of the last three years and the current year State and district-wise particularly in Misrikh Parliamentary Constituency of Uttar Pradesh and Gwalior and Shivpuri districts of Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) the total funds allocated and utilized in this regard during the said period, State and district-wise;
- (c) the number of roads that require sanction from the Union Government under the said yojana, State and district-wise; and
- (d) whether the Government has conducted any study on quality of roads under PMGSY during the said period and if so, the details thereof, State and district-wise and if not, the reasons therefor?

# <u>Statement referred to in reply to parts (a) to (d) of Lok Sabha Starred Question No. 385 (5<sup>th</sup> Position) due for answer on 28.03.2023</u>

(a) to (c) Misrikh Parliamentary constituency lies in Sitapur District. The details of works sanctioned, completed and balance under various interventions/ verticals of PMGSY in the last three years and the current year in Sitapur District of Uttar Pradesh and Gwalior and Shivpuri districts of Madhya Pradesh may be seen at **Annexure-I.** 

State and District-wise details (road list) of projects sanctioned, completed, balance and ongoing during the last three years and the current year may be seen at omms.nic.in>proposals>State-wise List of Roads.

Funds are released to the state as a whole and not district wise. The state-wise details of funds released as central share and expenditure incurred (including state share) during the last three years and the current year is given at **Annexure-II.** Further, district-wise details of expenditure incurred during the last three years and the current year may be seen at **omms.nic.in>Progress Monitoring>District Brief.** 

No roads of these districts are pending for sanction in the Ministry.

(d) PMGSY has a three-tiered Quality Control mechanism for ensuring construction of quality road works and durability of road assets under PMGSY. Under the **first tier**, the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) are required to ensure process control through mandatory tests on material and workmanship at the field laboratory. The **second tier** is a structured independent quality monitoring at the State level through State Quality Monitors (SQMs) to ensure that every work is inspected at initial stage, intermediate stage and final stage of the construction. Under the **third tier**, which is at the national level, independent National Quality Monitors (NQMs) are deployed for random inspection of road works to monitor quality and also to provide guidance of senior professionals to the field functionaries.

In the NQM inspections conducted from April 2019 to 17th March, 2023, 8.09% completed works, 6.45% ongoing works and 22.21% maintenance works have been graded as Unsatisfactory. The state-wise details of the same are given at **Annexure-III**. District-wise details may be seen at omms.nic.in> Quality>Quality (NQM Reports)>Quality Grading Abstract.
