CONSTRUCTION OF MAJOR PORTS

*437. SHRI LAVU SRI KRISHNA DEVARAYALU: SHRI BALASHOWRY VALLABHANENI:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state: पत्तन, पोत परिवहन और जलमार्ग मंत्री

- (a) whether the Ministry is planning to undertake construction of four major ports, 200 small and minor ports and 2,000 water ports in the country under Sagarmala project;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the locations where these major, small, minor and water ports are going to come up, State-wise;
- (c) whether any emphasis has been given on the East Coast of the country in view of 'Act East Policy' of the Government of India and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government is considering to make Andhra Pradesh a launch pad for this project in view of its nearly 1000 kms long coast line and if so, the steps taken in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a) to (d) A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.*437 ANSWERED ON 31ST MARCH 2023 RAISED BY SHRI LAVU SRI KRISHNA DEVARAYALU AND SHRI BALASHOWRY VALLABHANENI REGARDING "CONSTRUCTION OF MAJOR PORTS".

- (a) and (b) The power for establishment of new Major Ports and administrative control of Major Ports vests with the Central Government. Establishment and administrative control of Non-Major Ports are within the purview of respective State Governments through State Maritime Boards. Government of India has accorded inprinciple approval for development of Major Port at Vadhavan in Maharashtra on landlord port development model due to its natural advantages and growing requirement of import export trade of the country. Galathea Bay in Great Nicobar Island of Andaman & Nicobar Islands has also been identified for development of an International Container Transhipment Terminal due to its strategic location. Expression of Interest (EoI) for structuring the Project was invited on 28th January 2023.
- (c) As a part of Sagarmala Programme, more than 800 projects at an estimated cost of around 5.4 lakh crore have been identified for implementation during 2015 to 2035 across all coastal states on Eastern and Western side of the country. Sagarmala Programme includes projects from various categories such as modernisation of existing ports andterminals, new ports, terminals, RoRo& tourism jetties, enhancement of portconnectivity, inland waterways, lighthousetourism, industrialization around port, skilldevelopment, technology centres, etc.
- (d) Government of Andhra Pradesh has informed that four new ports are being developed in the state viz. (1) Ramayapatnam, (2) Machilipatnam, (3) Bhavanapadu, and (4) Kakinada SEZ. About 110 Projects worth more than Rs 1.1 Lac Cr. have been identified under Sagarmala Programme in the state of Andhra Pradesh for enhancing the infrastructure related to Port led Industrialization, Port Modernization, Port Connectivity enhancement, Coastal Community Development & Coastal Shipping, and Inland Waterways. These projects are implemented by Central Ministries, IWAI, Indian Railways, NHAI, State Government, and Major Ports etc.

In Andhra Pradesh, there are 14 projects worth Rs. 2,500 Cr partially funded throughSagarmala Programme. Out of these 14projects, 5 projects worth Rs.740 Cr have been completed, 5 projects worth Rs. 550 Cr. are under implementation and 4 projects worth Rs. 1,210 Cr. are under development.
