NILGIRI MOUNTAIN RAILWAY LOCOS

1049. SHRI A. RAJA:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Southern Railway has any plans to shift Nilgiri Mountain Railway locos which is based on coal and furnace oil, to diesel-powered engines;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the engines are likely to increase the speed of the Mountain trains apart from reducing pollution;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether adequate infrastructure has been made for maintenance of these locos which have received UN heritage status, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) & (b) Yes, Sir. Steam Loco Shed presently has a holding of 09 X-Class Steam Locos out of which 02 are coal fired, 03 are Diesel Fired and 04 are Furnace-oil fired. Converting furnace oil-fired locos to Diesel-fired locos is a continuous process.
- (c) & (d) Increasing speed of the engines is not feasible at present.
- (e) Yes, Sir. Loco Shed/Coonoor under Southern Railway has the following infrastructure for the maintenance of the locomotives operational at Nilgiri Mountain Railway (NMR) system;
- 1. Adequate maintenance machinery is available,
- 2. Adequate supervisory and maintenance staff are posted in the loco shed for maintenance of locos.
- 3. Periodic Overhauling (POH) of the locomotives is done once in four years at Golden Rock Workshop/Tiruchirappally (GOC).
