(a) to (d): Ministry of Railways under various schemes of Public Private Partnership (PPP) attracts private investment in various areas viz. network expansion, setting up of locomotive factories, induction of railway wagons, Station Re-Development, Building freight terminals etc. from the prospective stake holders and strategic investors.

Under PPP framework so far, 15 projects of network capacity augmentation amounting to ₹ 13,169 crore have been completed and 9 projects of ₹ 20,332 crore are under implementation.
