- (a) whether it is a fact that huge amount of compensation and royalty have not been paid yet by various coal companies in Jharkhand to the State Government and land losers and if so, the details thereof, district-wise along with the view of Union Government in this regard;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to fix any time frame to clear outstanding payment including Royalty at the earliest; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) Sir, as per information received from Coal India Limited (CIL), there are no outstanding dues in respect of payment of compensation from whom possession of land has been obtained. Royalty on coal is paid in advance. The subsidiary-wise royalty paid to Jharkhand State Government, as per annual accounts of CIL, during last 3 years is as under:-
