Piped Water Supply

1151. SHRI KANUMURU RAGHU RAMA KRISHNA RAJU:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government's proposal to ensure piped water supply to all rural households by 2024 is being implemented as per the schedule;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the status of the programme as on date, including the progress made along with the funds sanctioned and released so far for the State of Andhra Pradesh?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) to (c) To enable every rural household in the country, to have assured potable water through tap connection by 2024, Government of India in partnership with States is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) - Har Ghar Jal since August 2019.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission in August 2019, 3.23 Crore (17%) rural households were reported to have tap water connections. So far, as reported by States/UTs, as on 06.02.2023, around 7.87 Crore rural households have been provided with tap water connections in last three and half years under JJM. Thus, as on 06.02.2023, out of 19.36 Crore rural households in the country, around 11.10 Crore (57%) households are reported to have tap water supply in their homes. The States/ UTs have been advised to cover the remaining households within the Mission period. State/ UT-wise details, including the State of Andhra Pradesh, are **annexed**.
