1156. SHRI KULDEEP RAI SHARMA:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of LPG consumers in terms of percentage of total population of the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has been able to meet the requirement of LPG cylinders in Andaman and Nicobar Islands;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the steps being taken by the Government to enhance the number of LPG distributors to meet the demand of LPG cylinders; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to provide LPG connection to all the families in Andaman & Nicobar Islands and if so, the steps taken by the Union Government in this regard?

- (a) As on 01.01.2023, there are 31.37 crore domestic LPG consumers across the country covering 105.4% of estimated households based on census 2011. State-wise details are at **Annexure**.
- (b) to (d) Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies(OMCs) have reported that total demand in Andaman & Nicobar Islands in 2020-21 and 2021-22 was 11.08 and 12.05 TMT respectively. Total estimated number of Households in Andman & Nicobar Islands is 1.01 lakh and presently there are 1.22 lakh LPG consumers which includes 13447 PMUY beneficiaries. LPG requirements of the Union Territory is fully met from the bottling Plant at Port Blair with a storage capacity of 900 MT and 9 LPG distributors in Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
