RECARPETING OF AIRPORT

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION नागर विमानन मंत्री

be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government has data regarding the time taken for recarpeting of various airports in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has observed that recarpeting time for Calicut international airport is much higher than other airports of our country and if so, the steps taken to expedite the same;
- (c) the details of steps/measures taken to ensure that runway recarpeting at Calicut international airport does not affect the normal airline operations at the airport;
- (d) whether the runway recarpeting can affect various international airline operations to Calicut and if so, the steps taken to minimise the difficulties faced by commuters; and
- (e) whether there has been an increase in the aviation security fees at airports across the country and if so, the steps taken to ensure that such increase does not affect the airline fare across the country?

ANSWER

- (a): The time taken for recarpeting of major runway works during the last 5 years is attached as Annexure.
- (b): As per Airports Authority of India (AAI) Works Manual, the time period for resurfacing works costing more than Rs.15 crore is generally 13 to 18 months. The resurfacing works at Calicut Airport have already commenced and it is likely to be completed within 11 months.
- (c) & (d): In order to minimize the difficulties faced by the passengers and to mitigate the impact of recarpeting work on flight operations, the work has been planned from 10:00 Hrs. to 18:00 Hrs. IST. Accordingly, Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) has been issued for execution of the said work. No flights have been cancelled on account of runway resurfacing work but the flight have been rescheduled.
- (e): The last revised Aviation Security Fee (ASF) was implemented from 01st April, 2021. Further, ASF is a separate component of airline fare.
