- (a) whether Air India proposes to borrow some of its 4,000 paintings, sculptures and other artefacts including works by M.F. Husain, S.H. Raza and Salvador Dali ashtrays, to recreate the airline's history and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Ministry has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Ministry of Culture in a symbolic handing over of the art works that would be housed at the National Gallery of Modern Arts (NGMA) after they are transferred 'in six to seven months' from Mumbai where they are stored in a godown at Air India's office in Nariman Point; and
- (c) if so, the details and present status thereof?
