Ministry of Civil Aviation has launched Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS)- UDAN (Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik) on 21.10.2016 to enhance regional air connectivity across the country from unserved and underserved airports in the country and making air travel affordable to the masses. Interested airlines based on their assessment of demand on particular routes, submit their proposals at the time of bidding under UDAN.

As on 31.01.2023, a total of 461 routes connecting 73 airports including 9 heliports & 2 water aerodromes have been operationalised so far under the UDAN Scheme. More than 113.80 lakh people have availed benefit of the UDAN scheme since its inception.

Under the scheme, 73 routes involving six airports in Maharashtra namely Kolhapur, Jalgaon, Nanded, Nasik, Gondia & Sindhudurg, 98 routes involving six airports in Karnataka namely Bidar, Mysore, Vidyanagar, Hubli, Kalaburgi & Belgavi have been operationalised for UDAN flights.

Rupsi, Tezu, Tezpur, Pasighat, Jorhat, Lilabari, Shillong, Pakyong, Itanagar & Dimapur involving 58 routes have been operationalised under UDAN in the States of the North Eastern Region.
