### **CLEANLINESS SURVEY**

#### NO. 1272. SHRI KRUPAL BALAJI TUMANE:

Will the Minister for HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has recently conducted any cleanliness survey;
- (b) if so, the details along with its objectives and salient features thereof;
- (c) the criteria adopted for the selection of the cities for this purpose and the details of the indicators/parameters taken into account during the selection process;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to make it a better technological intervention through QR code based citizen feedback in order to widen the access to people and if so, the details thereof along with steps taken in this regard; and
- (e) the other steps being taken to make the cleanliness survey successful and to usher in awareness amongst all classes of the society for clean cities?

#### ANSWER

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a) & (b) : The latest cleanliness survey conducted in cities was Swachh Survekshan (SS) – 2022 whose results have been announced on  $1^{st}$  October, 2022.

Some of the key features of Swachh Survekshan-2022 includes, increased citizen participation by way of expanding field validation from the current 40% of wards to 100% of wards of all Urban Local Bodies (ULBs); safety, wellbeing and dignity of Safaimitras; district ranking introduced for the first time, circulatory in waste management; use of digitisation and technology for efficiency of data management and transparency; focus on monuments/ parks associated with freedom movement.

(c) : The criteria for selection of the cities and details of indicators/ parameters taken into consideration for selection of ULBs for ranking is annexed. Details of the indicators is provided in the Swachh Survekshan-2022 toolkit available at the following link :

(d) : Under Swachh Survekshan-2022 interventions like digital documentation, geo-tagging of facilities and Quick Response (QR) Code based citizen feedback has been initiated by way of end-toend use of SBM-U MIS portal 'Swachhatam', use of apps like "Swachhata Apps", etc.

(e) : Steps taken to create awareness amongst all sections of the society for cleaner cities in Swachh Survekshan-2022, include,

- (i). District ranking introduced to engage district administration in supporting smaller cities.
- (ii). New categories like Ganga Towns, Cantonment Board, and fastest moving cities.
