- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the salient features of MoU;
- (c) whether any time frame has been fixed for generation of renewable power under the said MoU;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the details of the sites and locations identified for setting up of power plants in the country, State/UT-wise particularly in Odisha, Maharashtra and the criteria fixed for selection of such sites?

- (a) & (b): NTPC Green Energy Limited (NGEL), and Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited (HPCL) have entered into Memorandum of Under Standing (MoU) for development of renewable energy-based projects in the country on 03.01.2023. The MoU envisages to collaborate for Development of grid connected and/ or off-grid Renewable Energy based Power Projects and/ or solutions to supply round the clock renewable energy which shall cater to requirement of HPCL and/or NGEL or any other customer mutually decided by NGEL & HPCL.
- (c) & (d): Time frame has not been fixed yet for generation of renewable power under the MoU.
- (e): Sites / locations have not yet been identified with reference to the above MoU.
