TAP WATER CONNECTIONS

NO. 1298. SHRI SUNIL BABURAO MENDHE:

Will the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government aims to provide tap water connections to every household in the cities and towns under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation 2.0 (AMRUT 2.0) scheme in the country, State-wise;**
- (b) if so, the meaning of water safe cities under this scheme along with its salient features thereof; and**
- (c) the number of cities selected under this scheme in the country, State-wise including Maharashtra??**

(a)& (b): Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0 envisages to make all notified statutory towns & cities of the country 'water secure' through circular economy of water focusing on universal coverage of functional water tap connections, water source conservation, rejuvenation of water bodies and wells, recycle/reuse of treated water, and rainwater harvesting. Total indicative outlay for AMRUT 2.0 is ₹2,77,000 crore including central share of ₹76,760 crore for five years from Financial Year 2021-22 to 2025-26.

Mission aims to provide water to the citizens with potable quality standards, in adequate quantity & available to every household through tap connection in all the statutory towns & cities across the country. So far, 2,996 projects worth ₹79,506 crore (Capital Expenditure) have been approved for water sector in 28 States/ Union Territories (UTs). State-wise list of water tap connections targeted under the Mission by these 28 States/UTs is placed at Annexure.

(c): Under AMRUT 2.0, all the statutory towns & cities of the country, including those in the State of Maharashtra, have been covered.
