INTEGRATED HOUSING AND SLUM DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

NO. 1352. SHRI M. SELVARAJ:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme has been implemented in Tamil Nadu;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the funds released to Tamil Nadu under the said programme during each of the last three years; and
- (d) the status of progress made so far in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a) to (d): The Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) was launched in the year 2005 and ended in the year 2012. Moreover, the Scheme was extended till 31.3.2017 for completion of already approved houses. Therefore, no fresh project proposal for release of fund was sanctioned during the last three years and the current year under the scheme. As on 23.01.2023, in Tamil Nadu, 94 projects for construction of 37,715 houses were sanctioned under IHSDP. Of the sanctioned houses, a total of 37,362 houses were grounded for construction; of which 37,259 were completed/ delivered. The Central Assistance of Rs. 400.34 Cr has been released till 31.03.2017.
