- (a) whether the Government is aware that National Highways (NHs) and its crossings have been severely encroached thus leading to road accidents and adversely affecting the free flow of traffic;
- (b) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto;
- (c) whether the Government takes *suo moto* cognizance of making NHs free from encroachment across the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Yes, Sir. There are instances of permanent and temporary encroachments on National Highways (NHs)' Right of Way (ROW) at different places particularly in urban/built up areas. Removal of encroachments on NH RoW is being done as per provisions of the Control of National Highways (Land and Traffic) Act, 2002. The implementing agencies of MoRTH carry out drive to remove encroachments from RoW periodically in coordination with concerned district administration.
