AYUSH Medicines in JAKs

Will the Minister of **CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is planning to introduce AYUSH medicines in Janaushadhi Kendras (JAKs);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether there are any operational guidelines for distributing AYUSH medicines in Janaushadhi Kendras, providing details about manufacture and supply of the medicines;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the number of products proposed to be introduced along with the nature of the infections they cover?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI BHAGWANTH KHUBA)

- (a) & (b): Under the *Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana* (PMBJP) implemented by the Pharmaceuticals & Medical Devices Bureau of India (PMBI), a society under the aegis of the Department of Pharmaceuticals, some AYUSH products, viz., Ayu Raksha Kit, Bal Raksha Kit, Ayush-64 tablet and Jan Aushadhi Chyawanprash Special have already been included in the product basket.
- (c) & (d): While Ayu Raksha Kit, Bal Raksha Kit and Ayush-64 tablet are being procured by PMBI from M/s Indian Medicines Pharmaceutical Corporation Limited (IMPCL), a Government of India Undertaking, Jan Aushadhi Chyawanprash Special is being procured from WHO-GMP certified manufacturer after following due tender process.
- (e): PMBI continuously strive to enhance its product basket so as to serve the needy patients. The product basket under the scheme presently comprises of 1,759 medicines and 280 surgicals.
