Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned the work of construction of super specialty department in North Bengal Medical College and Hospital (NBMCH), Siliguri, Darjeeling under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY);
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the current status of the project;
- (c) the expected date of handing over the super specialty department to the NBMCH authority; and
- (d) the other steps being taken by the Government to expedite the completion of the project?

(a) to (d): Upgradation of North Bengal Medical College and Hospital (NBMCH), Siliguri has been approved under Phase-III of Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) at an approved outlay of Rs.150 Crore (Central Share-Rs. 120 Crore and State Share-Rs. 30 Crore). The upgradation includes construction of 255 bedded Super Specialty Block (SSB) with 8 Operation Theatres and procurement of medical equipment. As informed by the Executing Agency, civil construction work has been completed. As per the NBMCH, Siliguri, OPD services are functional in the Super Speciality Block.
