(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Ordnance Factory Khamaria, a unit under Munitions India Limited (MIL), is having workload of variants of Tank Ammunition, Air Defence Weapon, Aerial Bombs, Grenades, etc. for supplies to Indian Armed Forces. The year-wise workload of Ordnance Factory Khamaria, for the current year and the next three years is as under:

Year	2022-23	2023-24	2024-25	2025-26
Workload	3158.00	2743.11	2168	2298.44

(c): No, Sir. No new work has been assigned to this factory during the current year.

(d) & (e): Yes, Sir. To meet the year-wise targets and to maintain continuity of production, Ordnance Factory Khamaria has procured most of the raw material for current year targets and 25% of the targets for the next year.
