(a to e) Government is aware of the issue of professionals having been laid off by US companies in recent months. Of these, a certain percentage is likely to be Indian nationals on H-1B and L1 visas.

Government of India has consistently raised issues relating to the movement of high skilled workers, including IT professionals, with the US Government. It has also been working with various stakeholders including industry organizations and business chambers on these issues.
