#### **TRANSFORMING PHCS INTO AB-HWCs**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- a) the details of Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs) registered/empanelled under Ayushman Bharat programme in the country, State/UT-wise;
- b) whether the Government had set a target of transforming existing 1,50,000 Sub-Health Centres (SHCs) and rural and urban Primary Health Centres (PHCs) across the country as Ayushman Bharat-Health and Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs) by December 2022;
- c) if so, the details thereof along with targets achieved so far, State/UT-wise including Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu;
- d) the details of PHCs and SHCs converted into AB-HWC in Gujarat along with the number of people who have availed services and benefitted from AB-HWCs in Gujarat during the period between 2018 and 2022; and
- e) whether there has been a steep decline of funds released by the Government under AB-HWCs for Andhra Pradesh and if so, the details thereof, year-wise for each of the last three years along with the reasons therefor?

#### ANSWER

# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (c): In February 2018, the Government of India announced 1,50,000 Ayushman Bharat-Health and Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs) to be established across the country by December 2022. The existing Sub- Health Centres (SHC), Primary Health Centres (PHC) and Urban Primary Health Centres (UPHC) are transformed into AB-HWCs to deliver Comprehensive Primary Health Care (CPHC) that includes preventive, promotive, curative, palliative and rehabilitative services which are universal, free, and closer to the community. As on 31.01.2023 a total of 1,56,412 AB-HWCs have been operationalized across the country. The operationalized HWCs, State/UTs wise is at **Annexure-I.** 

(d) As on 31.03.2022 Total of 7524 Nos. of UPHC, PHCs and SHCs have been converted into AB-HWC in Gujarat. A total number of 7,12,22,915 footfall has been recorded on these AB-HWCs in Gujarat during the period between 2018-22.
