#### **TELEMEDICINE SERVICE**

#### **1538: SHRI HARISH DWIVEDI**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH and FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has rolled out telemedicine service in the country and if so, the details thereof;

(b) the States/UTs in which telemedicine service is being implemented;

(c) the number of people so far treated though telemedicine service, State/UT-wise; and

(d) the district in Uttar Pradesh where rural people are being treated through telemedicine service?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (d): Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) has developed a telemedicine application known as National Telemedicine Service, eSanjeevani which provides doctor to doctor and patient to doctor consultations.

This application works on a hub and spoke model. Through the hub and spoke model, doctors including specialists can provide services to Health and Wellness Centers (HWCs) in rural areas. Further people in remote and rural areas can also avail services through OPD module of eSanjeevani.

The Government has also launched a "National Tele Mental Health Programme" on 10th October, 2022, to further improve access to quality mental health counselling and care services in the country. As on 31.01.2023, 25 States/ UTs have set up 36 Tele MANAS Cells and have started mental health services. 43,861 calls have been handled on the helpline number.

eSanjeevani Telemedicine service is implemented in all States/UTs.

As on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2023, eSanjeevani Telemedicine service has served a total of 6,03,89,750 patients across the country. State-wise detail is annexed herewith.

Telemedicine service eSanjeevani has been implemented in all 75 districts of Uttar Pradesh and as on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2023, a total of 33,24,186 patients in Uttar Pradesh.
