PROMOTING PASSENGER FERRY SERVICE

1547. SHRI BRIJENDRA SINGH:

Will the MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state: पत्तन, पोत परिवहन और जलमार्ग मंत्री

- (a) whether the Government is promoting roll-on/roll-off passenger (RO-Pax) ferry services as a fast and sustainable mode of transport;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of locations where RO-Pax jetties have been developed; and
- (d) whether the Government has plans in place for further development of such ferries in the future and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

- (a) & (b) Yes Sir, to introduce modern urban Ro-Ro/Ro-PAX (Roll on Roll off and Passenger) vessels as a mode of Inland Waterways Transport (IWT), the Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) have engaged into cooperation with State Governments. The details is at **Annex.-I**. Besides, under the Sagarmala Scheme, the Government has undertaken 50 projects of worth Rs. 1972 Cr. to promote Ro-Ro/ Ro-Pax/ Passenger ferry urban water transportation services in country, of which 10 projects worth Rs. 557 Cr. have already been completed.
- (c) The detail of locations where Ro-Ro/ Ro-Pax jetties/terminals developed is at Annex.II.
- (d) Apart from the facts mentioned in reply to point (a) & (b) above, development of Ro-Ro/Ro-Pax/Ferries and Ro-Ro terminals at following 10 locations (5 pairs) has been included under Arth Ganga Programme in Jal Marg Vikas Project (JMVP):-

- Kahalgaon (Bihar) Tintanga (Bihar)
- Bakhtiyarpur (Bihar) Hasanpur (Bihar)
- Buxar (Bihar) Saraikota (Uttar Pradesh)
- Samdaghat (Jharkhand) Manihari (Bihar)
