Closure/Privatization/Disinvestment of Central Public Sector Enterprises

1612. SHRI SISIR KUMAR ADHIKARI:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to close or privatize and/or disinvest the Central PSUs during the next two years and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of Central PSUs that are under the process of closure or privatisation and/or disinvestment, State/UT-wise including West Bengal; and
- (c) whether the Government proposes to modernise and expand capacity of Central PSUs for further development and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN MINISTRY OF FINANCE

(DR. BHAGWAT KISHANRAO KARAD)

(a) and (b) The Government, since 2016, has given 'in-principle' approval for strategic disinvestment of 36 cases of PSEs and/or Subsidiaries/ Units/ Joint Ventures of PSEs/ Bank. Out of the 36 cases, 33 cases are being handled by DIPAM and 3 cases are being handled by the respective Administrative Ministry/Department. Out of the 33 cases being handled by DIPAM, strategic disinvestment transactions have been completed in 10 cases; 5 PSEs are under consideration for closure; 1 case is held up due to litigation, 1 case is under Corporate

Insolvency Resolution Process (CIRP) in NCLT and 2 transactions are under review for feasibility. Remaining 14 transactions are at various stages. Details are given at **Annexure-I**.

In other PSEs, where the Government continues to retain control, disinvestment through minority stake sale is carried out through various SEBI-approved methods such as Initial Public Offer (IPO), Offer for Sale (OFS), Buyback of shares etc. from time to time based on prevailing market conditions and investor interest.

17 CPSEs are under the process of closure, as reported by Department of Public Enterprises. State-wise list of such CPSE/units of CPSEs is given at **Annexure-II.**

(c) Modernization and capacity enhancement of Central PSEs are ongoing processes, and steps in this regard are taken from time to time by the CPSEs keeping in view the requirements.
