One School One Sports Programme

†1618. SHRI SANJAY SETH:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that One School One Sports programme has been started by the Government to encourage sports and sports persons;
- (b) the number of States and schools in which such programmes have been started, State-wise;
- (c) whether there is any proposal in the scheme to link traditional sports under it;
- (d) if so, the details of sports which have been linked with schools in Jharkhand;
- (e) the details of the funds released for it, State-wise; and
- (f) the number of schools associated with it in Jharkhand?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

(DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) to (d): One School-One Sport policy is an initiative undertaken by the Ministry of Defence for Sainik Schools located across the country so that they can focus on at least one sporting discipline identified for the respective State/UT. Sainik Schools Society (SSS) has, in line with 'One State-One Sport' concept of Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, allocated one sport to each of the existing 33 Sainik Schools established under the erstwhile pattern of Sainik Schools including Sainik School in Jharkhand is detailed at Annexure-I. Under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, the concept of One State One Game (OSOG) has been designed keeping in mind India's preparedness in achieving excellence in Olympics 2024 and beyond. The long-term plan is aimed at making each State or Union Territory (UT) proficient in 2-3 sports disciplines in which it possesses a special aptitude for winning an Olympics medal and wherein the Central Government could provide support for soft components such as coaching, sports science equipment, sports equipment, support staff, etc.

Further, Department of School Education and Literacy has launched an Integrated Scheme – Samagra Shiksha for School Education. Realizing the need for holistic development of children, under the Samagra Shiksha, Sports and Physical Education component has been introduced for encouragement of Sports, Physical activities, Yoga, Co-curricular activities etc.

(e) & (f): Under Samagra Shiksha, provision has been made for grants for sports equipment in all government schools at the rate ranging from Rs. 5,000 to Rs. 25,000 for various levels of schools per annum. In addition, as per new norms of the scheme, an additional grant up to Rs. 25,000 per school is provided to schools in case at least 2 students of that school win the medal in Khelo India National school games competition. During 2022-23, an amount of Rs. 726.72 Crore has been estimated for the sports grant for all the States/UTs including an amount of Rs. 19.50 Crore for the State of Jharkhand for 15996 Government schools at various levels. The State wise allocation is at Annexure-II.
