SHORT TERM TRAINING PROGRAMME

1645. SHRIMATI SANDHYA RAY:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of short term training programmes that are available for women across the country;
- (b) the number of women who have completed their vocational training during last four years and were given wage employment in the industries Training/Institution and year wise in Madhya Pradesh; and
- (c) whether the government has proposed opening of more Training institutions in all the industrial hubs including Bhind, Datia districts of Madhya Pradesh and if so, the details thereof ?

ANSWER

(a) Under Skill India Mission, the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship(MSDE) delivers short term skills through various programmes to all the sections of the society across the country including women as mentioned below:

Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY):It is the flagship Scheme of MSDE with an objective to impart short duration skill development training and certification to youth and to make them employable for better livelihood across the country. In order to increase the participation of women, conveyance cost and boarding & lodging facilities are being provided to them.

Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS): Under JSS scheme of MSDE skill training is imparted skills to non-literate, neo-literates, and persons with rudimentary level of education upto 8th standard and school dropouts upto 12th standard in the age group of 15-45 years in rural and urban areas. Under the scheme, focus is being given to women and other vulnerable sections.

(b) Number of women trained in Madhya Pradesh under PMKVY and JSS during last four years i.e. from2018-19to2021-22 is asunder:

Amongst the schemes of the MSDE, placements are specifically tracked under PMKVY. Number of women placed in Madhya Pradesh under PMKVY during last four years i.e. from 2018-19 to 2021-22 is as under:

As far as employment of the JSS scheme beneficiaries is concerned, third party evaluation report of the scheme has observed that as an impact of the training programme conducted at JSSs, the self and wage employment and private job have become evident. The usefulness of the scheme is further evident from the fact that same report has mentioned that 77.05% of the beneficiary trainees have undergone occupational shifts.

(c) There is one Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) under PMKVY and one Jan Shikshan Sansthan under JSS scheme, each in Bhind and Datia districts of Madhya Pradesh. No proposal for opening such centre in the State of Madhya Pradesh is pending.
