SET-UP OF NEW KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS IN THENI

1686. SHRI P. RAVINDHRANATH:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of the proposal of setting up of new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) in Theni Parliamentary Constituency in Tamil Nadu;
- (b) whether there is any hurdle leading to inordinate delay in the tentative establishment of the said KVs;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the exact reasons for such an undue delay in setting up of new KVs in Theni?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) to (d) Opening of new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) is a continuous process. KVs are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the wards of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence & Para-military personnel, Central Autonomous Bodies, Central Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Central Institute of Higher Learning (IHL) by providing a common programme of education throughout the country. Proposals for opening of new KVs may be sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) Administrations, with commitment to provide requisite resources for setting up a new KV as per norms. The proposals including new KV at Theni are subject to approval of the competent authority.
