Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of the employment exchanges functioning/operational in the country particularly in Maharashtra;
- (b) the number of unemployed persons (men and women) registered in the employment exchanges during the last three years and the current year in the State of Maharashtra;
- (c) the number of persons including women who got employment through the employment exchanges during the said period in the State of Maharashtra;
- (d) whether the registered companies including both the domestic and multinational companies fulfil their manpower requirement through the employment exchanges; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (e): As per the extent of information received from the States/UTs, the total number of employment exchanges in the country were 1005 and out of which 36 were in Maharashtra during the year 2021. In Maharashtra, the number of job-seekers (employed/unemployed), who got registered themselves and got placement through employment exchanges during the last three years and the current year were as follows:
