BASIC FACILITIES AT MONUMENTS

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to provide basic facilities like drinking water, toilets, parking, road connectivity and guides etc. to tourist visiting monuments, historical temples and world heritage sites to promote tourism;
- (b) if so, the monument-wise details thereof; and
- (c) whether the Government has taken/proposes to take any steps to beautify and provide the said facilities at the pilgrimage sites located in Firozabad Parliamentary Constituency of Uttar Pradesh?

- (a) Yes. Sir. The Archaeological Survey of India (ASI), provides basic facilities like & drinking water, toilets, parking, road connectivity and guides etc. to tourist visiting
- (b) monuments historical temples and world heritage sites. The monuments - wise details of basic facilities are available at <https://asi.nic.in/facilities-at-monument/>.
- (c) There are 4 protected monuments, namely, Great Idgah, Tomb of Nasiruddin, Tomb of Nizammuddin, and Tomb of Fariduddin alias Mian Fiddu in district- Firozabad. All four monuments are in good state of preservation. Conservation works are being attended regularly. Facilities in monuments for toilet block for male, female and disabled, drinking water, parking, proper ramp, approach pathway, sitting arrangement to ensure basic tourist facilities in the monument complex at an estimated project cost of about 50 Lakhs have been approved.
