Will the Minister of **EDUCATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of all the projects being run by the Government for schools and Higher Education in Bihar and Haryana, district-wise;
- (b) the funds allocated/released and utilized by the Government for the said projects in Bihar and Haryana during the last three years and the current year, year/district-wise; and
- (c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government for effective implementation of the said educational projects in Haryana particularly Sonipat district and Bihar particularly Seohar, Sitamarhi, East Champaran and Bhagalpur districts?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)

(a) to (c): The district-wise details of higher education projects approved, central funds approved and released to various projects in the last three years and the current year under the scheme of Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) in Bihar and Haryana are at **Annexure-I.** The Government continuously reviews the implementation of the RUSA scheme and monitors the progress of the projects through regular review meetings with the State.

Further, one Indian Institute of Management (IIM) each is functioning in Rohtak District of Haryana and Gaya District of Bihar. The details of Funds released during the last three years including the current year to these IIMs are at **Annexure-II.**

In addition to this, one Indian Institute of Information Technology (IIIT) each is functioning in Bhagalpur District of Bihar and Sonepat District of Haryana. The details of Funds released during the last three years including the current year to these IIITs are at **Annexure-III.**

Additionally, Education is in the Concurrent List of the Constitution and a majority of the schools are under the jurisdiction of respective States and Union Territories (UT). The Central Government has launched an Integrated Scheme for School Education – Samagra Shiksha, from 2018-19 which is an overaching programme for the school education sector extending from pre-school to class XII and aims to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education at all levels of school education. The Scheme for school education 'Samagra Shiksha'

envisages the 'school' as a continuum from primary, upper primary, secondary to higher secondary levels. Under Samagra Shiksha, States and UTs are supported for strengthening of existing Government schools, and for creation and augmentation of infrastructure facilities including drinking water and toilets as per proposals received from respective State/UT based on the identified gaps. The details of central releases and expenditure including state share during the last three years in respect of Samagra Shiksha for the states of Bihar and Haryana is at **Annexure-IV.**
