Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has approved and disbursed Rs. 8,154 crore to the States under Article 293(3) of the Constitution of India for raising Open Market Borrowing (OMB) and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether during the month of October, 2022, as per the recommendations of the 15th Finance Commission, a total of Rs. 15,121.99 crore was also released to the States therefor and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including West Bengal, Meghalaya and Tripura thereof?

- (a) Yes Sir, the consent of Government of India under Article 293 (3) of the Constitution of India for raising Open Market Borrowing (OMB) of Rs. 8,000 crore and Rs. 154 crore have been allowed to the State Governments of Haryana and Meghalaya respectively in the month of October, 2022.
- (b) Yes Sir, during the month of October, 2022, as per the recommendations of the 15th Finance Commission, a total of Rs. 15,121.99 crore was released to the States as grant. State-wise details of the amount released is given in **Annexure**.
