MUDRA LOANS FOR SELF-EMPLOYED YOUTHS

1876. DR. SANGHMITRA MAURYA :

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of employed and self employed youths who have became entrepreneurs in the country, State-wise;
- (b) the State-wise details of the amount of Mudra loans in crore that have been provided to such youths; and
- (c) whether the news item published in the Hindustan 21.02.2023 the sectors in which the youths have been motivated to get employment and become entrepreneurs and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESHWAR TELI)

(a) to (c): The data source on Employment and Unemployment is Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) which is conducted by the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI) since 2017-18. The survey period is July to June of next year. As per the latest available Annual PLFS Reports, the estimated percentage of self-employed workers out of total employment was 55.8% during 2021-22. The State/UT-wise Worker Population Ratio (WPR) (i.e. Employment) and estimated percentage of self-employed workers in total employment during 2021-22 is at Annexure-I.

Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY) is being implemented by the Government for facilitating self-employment. Under PMMY, collateral free loans upto Rs. 10 lakh, are extended to micro/small business enterprises and to individuals to enable them to setup or expand their business activities. As on 20.01.2023, more than 38.53 crore loans have been extended since inception of the scheme in April 2015. State/UT-wise detail of loans under PMMY during 2021-22 and 2022-23 (till 20.01.2023) is at Annexure-II. Further, the Industry-wise percentage share of self employed in the total employment on usual status during 2021-22 is at Annexure-III.
