Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number and the details of the recognized Government/non-Government Universities/colleges in Chhattisgarh;
- (b) whether the adequate number of teachers/professors/principals and basic infrastructure are available in the said Universities/ college/ institutions as per the guidelines issued by the Government; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) Sir, presently, there are total 32 Universities and 276 Colleges in the State of Chhattisgarh recognized u/s 2(f) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 as per the details below:

List of the recognized Universities and Colleges is available on the UGC website. There is one Central University in the state of Chhattisgarh i.e. Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya established by the Act of Parliament in the year 2009 under the purview of this Ministry.

(b) & (c) Teaching position as on 01-02-2023 in respect of Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya is as under:

The colleges are established by a society / trust / company as per the norms specified by the State Government where the college is established. They fall under the administrative control of respective State Governments. The posts in affiliated colleges are sanctioned and filled by the State Governments, which is a dynamic process. The details of sanctioned and vacant posts of colleges are not centrally maintained. As per All India Survey on Higher Education report 2020-21, there are 22,613 teachers in position in Chhattisgarh. The development and maintenance of infrastructure in the State Universities and Colleges comes under the purview State Government and is responsibility of the State Government. This Ministry under the Scheme RashtriyaUchchatarShikshaAbhiyan has released Rs. 220.13 crore so far to the State of Chhattisgarh.
