Delay in declaring the Results of Degree Courses

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the University of Delhi has fixed any deadline for declaring the results of various degree courses offered through regular and correspondence mode;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the declaration of results of graduation and post-graduation courses particularly of correspondence mode are delayed by several months by the University of Delhi;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (e) whether the Government has taken any measures to ensure the declaration of results of various degree courses of correspondence mode offered by the University of Delhi within a fixed time period; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) to (f): Graduation and Post Graduation courses in University of Delhi run on Semester pattern- January to June & July to December. Accordingly, the examinations for these two semesters usually initiate by the first week of May and December respectively. After completion of examinations the evaluation of answer sheet starts in various evaluation centres which is a manual exercise. The declaration of results for various courses can be done only after the receipt of awards from various evaluation centres. In last two years, the result of both graduation and post-graduation courses particularly of correspondence mode were delayed during Covid-19 pandemic. The University has taken measures by establishing more Evaluation Centres with adequate number of teachers for quick evaluation of answer scripts for timely declaration of result.
