- (a) whether it is a fact that the Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India Limited (TRIFED) has proposed to get Geographical Indication (GI) tag for tribal products and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether any tribal products have been selected from the State of Gujarat for GI tagging and if so, the details thereof, district-wise and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the progress made so far in obtaining these GI tags; and
- (d) the details of the tribal products that have GI tags at present?
