- (a) the number of people who are registered in the National Career Service (NCS) project who got a job from the Private and Government sector respectively, year-wise and State-wise;**
- (b) the total number of people registered since 2015 in the NCS project who got a job from the Private and Government sector respectively, year wise and State-wise;**
- (c) the year-wise and State-wise percentage of women who are registered in the NCS project who got a job from the Private and Government sector respectively, out of the total number of people registered, since 2015;**
- (d) the aims and objectives of launching the NSC and challenges faced by the Government while implementing NCS;**
- (e) the total number of job-seekers employed through the NCS portal during each of the last three years and the current year in Uttar Pradesh; and**
- (f) the total number of persons from Uttar Pradesh who have secured jobs through the portal in the public and private sector during each of the last three years and the current year?**

(a) to (f): The National Career Service (NCS) project is being implemented by the Government to provide a variety of employment related services like job search and matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses etc. through a digital platform [www.ncs.gov.in]. The NCS project aims to provide seamless access to jobseekers and employers, decent employment opportunities to the aspiring youth of the country and to facilitate career development assistance. The State-wise and year-wise details of the jobseekers registered on the portal is at Annexure I. Further, State-wise and year-wise percentage of women registered on NCS is at Annexure II.

Notifying final hiring figures is not a mandatory requirement on NCS portal. However, a total of approximately 1.30 crore vacancies have been mobilized on NCS portal till 1st March, 2023, including the vacancies of public and private sector all over India, including the state of Uttar Pradesh. State-wise number of vacancies mobilized is at Annexure III.
