2054. SHRI PRADYUT BORDOLOI:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of candidates trained and placed under PMKVY 1.0, 2.0 and 3.0, Statewise:
- (b) whether the Government has assessed reasons for the low rate of placement of trained candidates under PMKVY and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any consultation with industry partners to assess reasons for low placement and scope for improvement;
- (d) the details of allocation and utilization of funds under PMKVY from 2015 till date;
- (e) whether low utilization of funds under PMKVY has been observed, if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (f) whether the Government is taking any steps to link training courses, curriculum and practical skills given under PMKVY with industry needs?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

- (a) The State wise details of candidates trained/oriented and reported placed under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) (PMKVY 1.0 to PMKVY 3.0) as on 31.12.2022 are placed at **Annexure.**
- (b)& (c) PMKVY has two components namely Short Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Placement opportunities are facilitated to STT certified candidates, while RPL is not linked with placements as it recognized the existing skills of candidate. Since inception i.e. 2015, till 31.12.2022, 56.64 lakh candidates have been certified under STT; Out of certified candidates, 24.36 lakh candidates have been reported placed in various sectors across the country which is around 43%. As per the evaluation study conducted of PMKVY 2.0 by NITI Aayog, the training provided under the scheme is relevant to the employers and they prefer candidates trained under PMKVY compared to untrained candidates.

In order to enhance the placement under the short term training of PMKVY, the last tranche, i.e., 30 percent of total payout is disbursed to training providers only on ensuring placement of the candidates. Also, RozgarMelas are organized to facilitate the placement.

(d) & (e) Under PMKVY since 2015, Rs. 11,880.50 crore have been allocated, out of which Rs. 9,903.83 crore have been utilized. Under the State component of the PMKVY 2.0, due to poor performance of the States, the financial allocation was rationalized from ₹3,050 crore to ₹2,419 crore (approximately). The reason for low performance of States includes delay in release of funds from State's treasury to SSDM, different payment process followed

by States/UTs, delay in submission of the UCs by States/UTs, slow clearance of technical / operational impediment with regard to on-boarding on SMART, SDMS, AEBAS, Skill India Portal etc.

(f) In order to improve the availability of skilled professional across the country, competency based skill development training aligning with National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) is being imparted under the scheme. NSQF-aligned job roles are developed by industry-led Sector Skill Councils (SSCs) covering various sectors.
