Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that one tiger dies in every 40 hours in the country and if so, the various steps taken by the Union Government to address the same during the last three years;
- the total funds allocated for the protection and care of tigers during the last three years; (b)
- the details of the deaths of tigers reported along with the names of the States whether (c) maximum occurance of death of tigers are being reported, State-wise; and
- (d) the details of the deaths of tigers during the last three years as reported in the daily newspaper Hindustan dated 21 February, 2023?

- No Sir. The average life span of the tigers in the wild is generally 10-12 years and in (a) & (b) the wild several factors like old age, diseases, internecine fights, high infant mortality, electrocution, snaring, drowning, road/rail hits etc. account for majority of tiger deaths. As per All India Tiger Estimation 2018, tiger population in India was estimated to be 2967 (SE range 2,603 to 3,346). Tiger population is increasing at a rate of 6% per annum in India when consistently sampled areas were compared from 2006 to 2018. Funding assistance is provided under the ongoing Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Project Tiger to tiger range States for conservation of tigers, raising awareness on tiger & other wildlife conservation, habitat management, protection, eco-development, human resource and infrastructure development, voluntary village relocation. The details of funds allocated and released to the tiger range States under the ongoing Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Project Tiger during last three years and the current year are at Annexure-I.
