2092. SHRI SATYADEV PACHAURI: SHRI JAGANNATH SARKAR:

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken any steps to generate awareness among Scheduled Caste (SCs) and Scheduled Tribes (STs) about the provisions of law aimed at ending discrimination, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (b) the details of the various schemes running with Central assistance for the social development and empowerment of SCs and STs in Uttar Pradesh; and
- (c) the details of the funds disbursed and utilized for social development and empowerment of SCs and STs during 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SHRI RAMDAS ATHAWALE)

(a): An Act of Parliament namely the Protection of Civil Rights {PCR} Act, 1955, prescribes punishment for enforcement of any disability arising from practice of 'untouchability'. Likewise another Act of Parliament namely the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) {PoA} Act, 1989, has been enacted to prevent the commission of offences of atrocities against members of Scheduled Castes(SCs) and Scheduled Tribes(STs). For the effective implementation of these Acts, a Centrally Sponsored Scheme is in force to provide admissible Central assistance to State Governments and Union Territory Administrations for inter-alia, Awareness Generation and Publicity as well.

Further, a National Helpline against Atrocities (NHAA) for the members of Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes has been also launched by the Department of Social Justice & Empowerment. The objective of the helpline is to generate awareness about the provisions and processes under the Law that are aimed at ending discrimination and provide protection. The NHAA is available on toll-free number '14566' across the country.

- (b): The details of various schemes/programmes run with Central Assistance for the social development and empowerment of SCs & STs by this Department and Ministry of Tribal Affairs in the States/UTs including the State of Uttar Pradesh are attached as Annexure I & II respectively.
- (c): The State-wise details of the funds disbursed for social development and empowerment of SCs and STs by this department and Ministry of Tribal Affairs during 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 are attached as **Annexure III and IV**.

B. Central Sector Schemes:-

Central Sector schemes are implemented directly by this department without involvement of States/UTs. As such, State/UT wise information is not available under the schemes. Under proviso to Grants under Article 275(1) of the Constitution, funds are provided for activities related to education, health, sanitation, water supply, livelihood, skill development, minor infrastructure etc. with the objective of development of scheduled area and also the welfare of Scheduled Tribes (STs).

(b) Ministry of Tribal Affairs is implementing a Scheme "Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs)" with the objective of overall socio-economic development and welfare of these most vulnerable sections among tribal people. Funds are provided to the concerned State Government / UT on the basis of their proposals in diverse sectors i.e. education, housing, land development, agricultural development, animal husbandry, construction of link roads, installation of non-conventional sources of energy for lighting purpose, conservation of culture and traditional practices or any other innovative activity with respect to these identified 75 PVTG communities in the nature of gap filling intervention besides interventions undertaken by the States out of Tribal Sub-Plan funds.

(c) Under the scheme of EMRS, funds are released by the Ministry to an autonomous society, National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS) for implementation of the scheme and NESTS further releases funds to State Societies and Construction Agencies etc. as per their requirements. Upto the year 2019-20, funds were being released to states including Uttar Pradesh for this scheme under Grants under Article 275 (1) of the constitution as one of the components. From the year 2020-21 onwards, separate allocation has been made for EMRS scheme and the details of fund allocation to NESTS for release of funds to State Societies and Construction Agencies etc. including Uttar Pradesh by the Ministry from the year 2020-21 onwards is as under:

(d) Till the year 2020-21 under the scheme of Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS), 100% grants were provided to the State Governments with notified STs including Uttar Pradesh interalia for activities related to education, health, sanitation, water supply, livelihood, skill development, minor infrastructure etc. for the development of Scheduled Tribes (ST).

During 2021-22, MoTA has revamped the existing Scheme of 'Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS) with nomenclature 'Pradhan Mantri Adi Adarsh Gram Yojna (PMAAGY)', for

implementation during 2021-22 to 2025-26, which aims at transforming villages with significant tribal population into model village (Adarsh Gram). (f) The Ministry of Tribal Affairs has been implementing the following Scholarship Schemes to promote and encourage basic and higher education amongst ST population. These Schemes are also implemented in the States of Uttar Pradesh:

i) Pre-Matric Scholarship for ST students (Class IX and X)

ii) Post Matric Scholarship for ST students (Class XI and above)

iii) National Fellowship and Scholarship for Higher Education for ST students.

iv) National Overseas Scholarship for ST students.

Out of the schemes mentioned above, the scholarship schemes at Sl.No (i) to (ii) are Central Sponsored Schemes and implemented by respective State/UT Govt. Both pre & Post Matric Scholarship Schemes are open ended Schemes wherein scholarships are given to all eligible students for pursuing studies from class 9th to Ph.D, whose parental income is up to Rs.2.5 lakh per annum. The calling of applications, verification, selection of beneficiaries is the responsibility of the States/UTs. The Ministry of Tribal Affairs, releases funds to States/UTs based on proposals submitted by them and after examining financial and physical progress. State Governments/Union Territory Administrations disburse the scholarship amount to all the eligible ST Student's bank account through DBT mode.

The Schemes at Sl.No. (iii) & (iv) are Central Sector Schemes. There are no state-wise allocation of slots and funds under these Central Sector Schemes. Under National Fellowship and Scholarship for Higher Education for ST students, funds are directly released to the Students/Institutions through DBT mode whereas National Overseas Scholarship for ST students is implemented by through the Ministry of Tribal Affairs. There is no state-wise allocation of funds under these Central Sector Schemes.

Central Sponsored Schemes i.e., Pre Matric Scholarship Scheme & Post Matric Scholarship Schemes are open ended Schemes implemented by respective States/UT admn. - (g) TRI and Media Division is administrating the centrally sponsored scheme "Support of Tribal Research Institute" under which grants are given to the state Tribal Research Institutes (TRIs) for various projects including preservation and promotion of their art, culture, practices, traditions in following ways:
 - (i) Research studies/publication of books/documentation including audio visual documentaries on promotion of rich tribal cultural heritage which includes preservation of tribal languages.
 - (ii) Tribal cultural exchange programmes.
 - (iii) Research and documentation of Indigenous practices by tribal healers and medicinal plants, Adivasi Languages, agriculture system, dances and paintings, organization of literary festivals, publication of books written by tribal writers/ authors, translation works and literature competitions, etc.
 - (iv) To acknowledge the heroic and patriotic deeds of tribal unsung heroes, Ministry has sanctioned setting up Tribal Freedom Fighters Museum for ten states. This museum along with ethnographic Tribal museums will also showcase and preserve tribal artefacts related to life and culture of tribes.
 - (v) Ministry gives funding to states/UTs for organizing tribal festival at State level.
 - (vi)The Ethnographic Museum of the states preserve and showcase rare artifacts related to life and culture of various tribes.
 - 2. Ministry is releasing funds to States under centrally sponsored scheme Support to TRI based on their proposal through Apex Committee Meeting. Details of funds released under the Scheme of 'Support to Tribal Research Institutes are as under:
