Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that State of Punjab is depopulating fastest in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government is aware that Punjab stands highest in the country at 859 people among number of Indians going abroad against the national average of 163 and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is aware of the consequences of this as ageing and unproductive population is left behind in Punjab and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to deal with situation consequent to the mass exodus and if so, the details thereof?

- (a): Decadal growth rate of population during 2001-2011 is 13.9 in the State of Punjab, which is not the lowest in India. A statement showing State-wise decadal growth rate during 2001-2011 is given at Annex.
- (b): As per data available on the eMigrate Portal 10,654 Emigration Clearances (ECs) have been issued to Emigration Check Required (ECR) category workers from Punjab as against 3,73,434 ECs at all India level in

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(c) & (d): The percentage share of population in the State of Punjab in the age-group of 15-59 is 64% in comparison to 60.3% at all India level as per Census 2011.
