Computerization of PACS

2116. SHRI TAPIR GAO:

Will the Minister of COOPERATION (सहकारिता मंत्री) be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of implementation of computerization of Primary Agriculture Credit Society (PACS), State wise;
- (b) the changes observed therein as a result of digitization; and
- (c) the number of farmers who have been benefitted from the above?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): There are nearly 1 lakh Primary Agricultural Credit Societies (PACS)/ Large Area Multi-Purpose Societies (LAMPS) with a member base of around 13 crore farmers. A Centrally sponsored project for Computerization of 63,000 functional PACS/ LAMPS across the country with a total financial outlay of Rs. 2,516 Crore is under implementation. The project entails bringing all the functional PACS onto an ERP (Enterprise Resource Planning) based common software, linking them with NABARD through State Cooperative Banks (StCBs) and District Central Cooperative Banks (DCCBs).

At present, proposal for computerization of 54,752 PACS has been received from the States/UTs and central share amounting to Rs. 201.18 crore has been released for the procurement of hardware, digitization of legacy data and establishing support system.

The State-wise details of PACS recommended for computerization under the project is attached as *Annexure*. The Project Monitoring Units (PMUs) have been set up at Central and State Levels by NABARD. Development of software has started by the National Level Project Software Vendor (NLPSV) selected by NABARD. Process for empanelment of System Integrators (SIs) is going on and the list of SIs will be shared with the States/ UTs shortly.

Computerization of PACS will provide various benefits such as increasing the efficiency of their operations, ensuring speedy disbursement of loans, lowering of transaction costs, reducing imbalances in payments, seamless accounting with DCCBs and StCBs and increasing transparency. Implementation of Common Accounting System (CAS) and Management Information System (MIS) would enable PACS to carry out their operations online and obtain refinance/ loans for their various activities from NABARD through DCCBs and StCBs.
