EXPENDITURE AND DEVELOPMENT UNDER GKRA

2201. SHRI MAHABALI SINGH:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total expenditure made under the Garib Kalyan Rozgar Abhiyan (GKRA);
- (b) the details of the basic infrastructure developed under GKRA; and
- (c) the details of the new steps taken in Rohtas, Bihar to promote skill and entrepreneurship for rural development?

ANSWER

(a) In the wake of Covid-19 pandemic, Government of India launched Garib Kalyan Rozgar Abhiyaan (GKRA) of 125 days on 20th June, 2020 to boost employment and livelihood opportunities for returnee migrant workers and similarly affected citizens in rural areas. The GKRA ended on 22nd October, 2020 and a total of 50.78 crore person-days employment were generated with a total expenditure of Rs. 39,293 crores during the Abhiyaan.

(b) The details of achievements/works completed under the GKRA are given at **Annexure**.

(c) There are multiple steps taken by the Government to create employment in rural areas. Some of the notable initiatives are listed below:

- (i) Project 'UNNATI', launched in December 2019 by Government of India, is a skilling project that intends to upgrade the skill base of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) workers, and thereby improve their livelihoods so that they can move from the current partial employment to full employment.
- (ii) There are two skill development programmes for rural youth under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM), namely, Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) and Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs). Both these programmes are aimed at increasing employability of rural youth, either for wage employment or self-employment.
- (iii) Start-up Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP) under DAY-NRLM programme supports the Self-Help Groups and their family members to set-up small enterprises in the non-farm sector.
- (iv) The Ministry has launched the Rural Mason Training (RMT) program under the Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) to address the issue of insufficient number of skilled masons for construction of quality PMAY-G houses. The initiative additionally generates livelihood opportunities for the rural workforce.
