SMALL AND MARGINAL FARMERS UNDER PMFBY

2202. COL. RAJYAVARDHAN RATHORE:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of marginal and small farmers insured under the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) in the country as of 2023, State-wise particularly in Rajasthan;
- (b) whether climate change is leading to new diseases affecting crop health and farminsurance claims have risen due to extensive crop damage caused by extreme weather conditions;
- (c) the details of the sums paid as insurance payouts to farmers affected by the above, yearwise and State-wise for the past three years; and
- (d) the number of farmers claiming farm insurance due to crop damage in the past three years and the average per capita compensation paid to them, year-wise?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): State-wise details of small & marginal farmers applications enrolled during 2022-23 under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) are given in **Annexure-I.**

It is true that the climate change is affecting the crop health and production. But Government is committed to provide financial security to farmers against the crop loss due to adverse climatic conditions. In order to secure the farmers against the crop yield losses due to natural risks/calamities, adverse weather conditions, pests & diseases etc. two major crop insurance schemes namely, Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) and Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme (RWBCIS) are being implemented by the Government. PMFBY provides comprehensive risk coverage from pre-sowing to post harvest losses against non-preventable natural risks. The RWBCIS provides indemnification for likely crop losses due to deviation in weather indices.

Only those farmers who insure their crops under the PMFBY/RWBCIS are eligible for the claims in case of any damage occurred to their crops as per the procedure defined in the Operational Guidelines of the Scheme, therefore, the question of per capita compensation does not arise. State-wise details of farmer applications enrolled, farmer applications paid claims and claims paid during 2019-20 to 2021-22 under PMFBY are given in **Annexure-II**.
