SHRIMATI SUPRIYA SULE:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of villages covered by the National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) in the States of Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra;
- (b) whether the Government has any data to boost Self Help Groups (SHGs) in rural economies across States, if so, the details thereof, State-wise and district-wise particularly in Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra;
- (c) whether NRLM has been successful in providing training to the youth from backward/ remote villages living below poverty line during the last three years in the States of Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (e) the amount of funds allocated by the Government during the last three years under NRLM to Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu and North Eastern Region; and
- (f) the number of beneficiaries under the Mission in the States of Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT
(SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) A total of 51,479 and 38,039 villages have been covered under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) in the State of Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra respectively till 28th February 2023 .

(b) DAY-NRLM is a flagship poverty alleviation scheme. It aims to create sustainable livelihoods by targeting the marginalised/deprived community & build a strong social capital of the poor households. Under the Mission , financial grant is being provided to Self Help Groups(SHG) in the form of Revolving Fund (RF) and Community Investment Fund (CIF) and SHGs are also being facilitated to access Bank loans. These funds are utilised by SHG members for the their consumption needs and also to take up income generation activities. The details of Bank loan disbursed to SHGs and the RF and CIF amount provided to the SHGs in the last two financial year and current financial year are given at Annexure-I.

(c) & (d) Ministry of Rural Development is implementing the following two sub schemes under DAY-NRLM in the field of skill development for rural poor youth (including those from backward/ remote villages) :-

- I. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) which is a placement linked skill development program for wage employment.
- II. Skill development through Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs) is enabling a trainee to take Bank credit and start his/her own enterprise.

Both the above schemes are demand driven schemes and are providing placement/ settlement to rural poor youth after skill development training. The total number of candidates trained and placed/settled

under DDU-GKY and RSETIs during the last three financial years in the States of Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu is given in the tables below:
