SOCIAL AUDIT CONDUCTED IN GRAM PANCHAYAT

2219. SHRI BASANTA KUMAR PANDA:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the percentage of the Gram Panchayats where at least once a Social Audit of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) has been conducted during the current year, State-wise;
- (b) the percentage of the Gram Panchayats where Action Taken Report (ATR) have been submitted and issues closed on the grievances received under the social audit, Statewise;
- (c) the names of the successful districts which have completed both the 100 percent of its social audit of MGNREGS along with 100 percent of the issues closed, raised under the social audit; and
- (d) whether the Government is taking any steps to speed up the process of social audit and closure of the issues raised under it with ATR, wherever delayed as being social audit a crucial part of the rural development schemes to fix the accountability, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): States/UTs-wise details of the Gram Panchayats where at least once Social Audit of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) has been conducted during the current financial year 2022-23 is given at **Annexure-I.**

States/UTs-wise details of social audit conducted in the current financial year 2022-23 are given at **Annexure-II.**

The names of districts where 100% social audit has been conducted in the current financial year 2022-23 are given at **Annexure III.** In no district, all issues raised by Social Audit Unit (SAU) in the current financial year 2022-23 are closed.

Ministry has taken various steps in this regard such as:

(i) MoRD has conducted a State-wise Training Program on Social Audit and MIS process for States/UTs. The Issues of action taken reports (ATR) uploading and closing and other procedural issues were discussed in detail with feasible solutions to support the States/UTs and strengthen the current social audit system & MIS process. All supporting training materials were shared with States/UTs for reference purposes.

(ii) Regular follow-up and monitoring are done by the Ministry on matters such as uploading of social audit calendar, completion of social audit as per target, disposal of issues raised by SAU and subsequent actions of recovery and other needful actions.
